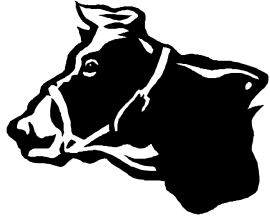

Pam Jahnke - *Farm Director, Wisconsin Farm Report Radio*

Born and raised on her family's 200-acre dairy farm in northeastern Wisconsin, Pam is deeply rooted in agriculture with a background including 4-H and FFA activities, exhibiting dairy at county fairs, and reigning as Oconto County Dairy Queen. After studying broadcast journalism and agriculture at UW-River Falls, Pam launched her career in the field she feels is "exactly what she's made for"- farm broadcasting and communicating on behalf of food producers.

Pam served as the 2010 president of the National Association of Farm Broadcasting, and her prior recognition as NAFB "Farm Broadcaster of the Year" for the western states earned her a special commendation from the Wisconsin State Senate. Pam has also been named a "Friend of Agriculture" by the Wisconsin Department of Agriculture, and she was awarded the "Agri-Marketing Person of the Year" by the Badger Chapter of the National Agri-Marketing Association.

In her spare time, Pam is active in her church and farms in a partnership with her brother, sister and parents. Her daily reports can be heard on WEKZ-FM 93.7 based out of Monroe WI, along with other stations in WI and MN.
